### **What is the Darebin Parklands Association Junior Rangers Club?**

The Darebin Parklands Association is a voluntary group that has cared for the park since 1973. The Junior Rangers is the DPA's kids' club. It's all about young people having fun in the park and helping to care for the environment.

### **What activities do Junior Rangers do?**

Throughout the year the DPA holds special "just for kids" events, including spotlighting and bonfire night. These events are free for Junior Rangers. Junior Rangers are also encouraged to come along to Park Care Days and learn about planting trees and keeping the park environment clean and healthy. Other fun activities include the Catch-a-Carp Day.

Each time Junior Rangers attend an event in the park, they get a stamp on their membership card. At each Park Care Day and at the end of the year, Junior Rangers can use their cards to enter the draw for great prizes, including the Junior ranger end of year camp out.

### **Are Junior Ranger activities supervised and safe?**

DPA volunteers and rangers attend all events but for safety reasons, parents must accompany children to Junior Ranger activities.

### **Who can join?**

Junior Rangers is open to all children under 15 years old. Other young people are encouraged to join the DPA as student members.

### **How do I join?**

### **How much does it cost?**

Junior Ranger memberships cost \$2 or are free as part of family memberships. These cost as little as \$10 a year.
